Finnish Medicines Agency Fimea's price list for services priced according to commercial criteria

The Finnish Medicines Agency Fimea may provide specialist services to its stakeholders that are not directly related to the statutory duties of a government agency. These specialist services are priced according to commercial criteria and the unit prices are indicated in the list below. Specialist services provided by Fimea are based on Fimea's competence in the pharmaceutical sector in general and in pharmaceutical safety in particular.

Under section 9 of the Act on Criteria for Charges Payable to the State, section 4 of the Decree issued by the Ministry of Social Affairs and Health on fees chargeable by the Finnish Medicines Agency (346/2015), and section 34 of the Act on the Openness of Government Activities (621/1999), the Finnish Medicines Agency Fimea prescribes the following fees:

Training services

Services charged on an hourly basis (minimum 1 hour). The price includes standard preparation for the training session and any related materials. If providing the training requires non-standard preparation (data acquisition and editing, a new subject area, lecturing in a non-native language etc.), time spent on preparations will be invoiced as work performed by an assistant.
